That's Jesus!***

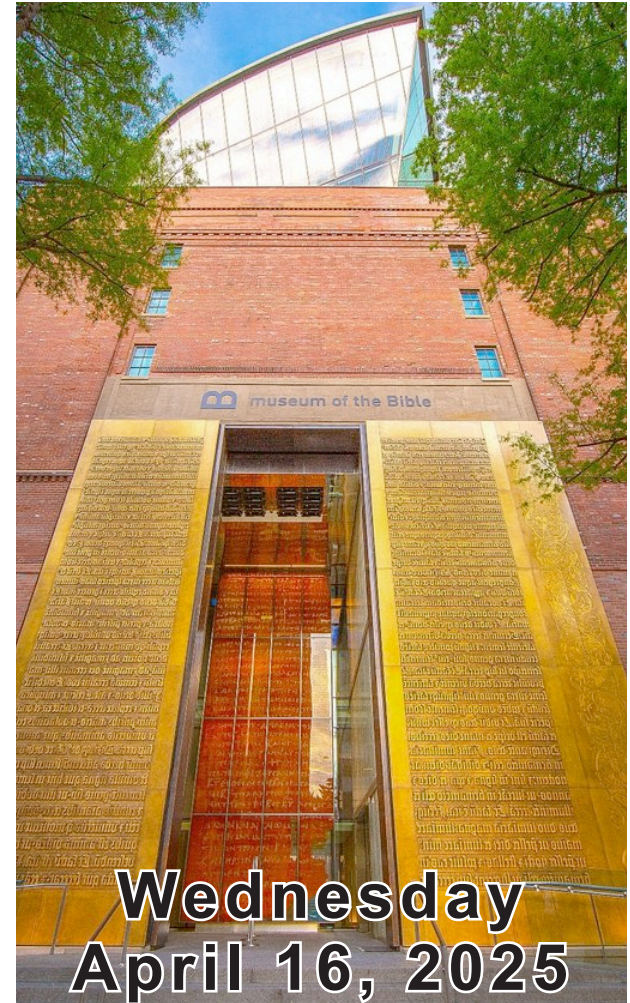
